Papaver Socks





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Materials: approx. 60 g [2.1oz] MC black (sock yarn by Atelier Zitron Trekking XXL (order # 2010, yardage 420 m/100g [460 yds/3.5 oz]); and approx. 50 g [1,8oz] CC Color 4061 or 4065 regenbogen (sock yarn by Zwerger Garn Opal Surprise! LL425m/100g [465 yds/3.5 oz]); DPN set 2.5 mm [US1.5] and 3.0 mm [US2.5]

Size: German 38-41 [US7.0-9.5] Gauge per 10×10 cm $[4 \times 4$ in] in colorwork pattern: 35 sts $\times 38$ rows.

Instructions

Leg: Using DPN set 2.5 mm [US1.5] and **MC**, cast on 72 sts, and divide the sts as follows: 18-18-18.

1.-8.Rnd knit MC

9.Rnd CC *K2tog, yarn over; rep from *

10.Rnd CC knit

11.-15.Rnd knit MC

Change to the bigger DPNs. Continue from **Chart Leg**, working Rounds 1–24. Repeat **Chart Leg**. Start the heel flap after Round 24.

Heel flap:

Switch to smaller DPNs. Worked with **MC** over 34 sts from Ndl 4 to Ndl 1. Slip 1 st from Ndl 1 to Ndl 2 and slip 1 st from Ndl 4 to Ndl 3.

Row 1 (RS) *sl1 purlwise with yarn in back (pwise wyb), k1* sl1 pwise wyb, k1; rep from*. **Row 2** (WS) sl1 purlwise with yarn in front (pwise wyf), purl to end. **Row 3** (RS) sl1 pwise wyb, * sl1 pwise wyb, k1; rep from* to last st, k1. **Row 4** (WS): Repeat Row 2. Work 34 rows, ending with a WS row.

Heel turn:

Row 1 (RS): k19, k2tog, k1, turn.

Row 2: slip 1, p5, p2tog, p1, turn.

Row 3: slip 1, k to 1 st before the gap, k2tog, k1, turn.

Row 4: slip 1, p to 1 st before the gap, p2tog, p1, turn.

Repeat Rows 3 and 4 until all sts are used up = 20 sts remain.

Gusset: Slip 1 st from Ndl 2 to Ndl 1 and slip 1 st from Ndl 3 to Ndl 4. From both side edges of the heel flap, pick up and knit 17 sts ea and divide the sts as follows: 28-18-18-28 sts. Change to the bigger DPNs.

Working Rounds 1–43 from **Gusset and Foot Chart** =72sts. For smaller and larger sizes than indicated, knit accordingly less or more rounds. For the transition to the top knit Round 44. Break **CC**.

Toe:

Knit with **MC** 2 round, then in every other round, always k2tog the thirdand second-to-last st of Needles #1 and #3, and k2tog the first and second st of Needles 2 and 4, until only 9 sts remain on each needle. From here on, continue decreases in <u>every</u> round, until only 8 sts remain in

all. Thread yarn held double through these remaining sts and cinch.

Carefully hide all ends, fold over and sew on picot edging.

Work the second sock the same way.

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
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
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
