

Chullo Nomen



Materials: approx. 50 g [1.8 oz] **MC** green and 40 g [1.6 oz] **CC** black sport weight wool yarn **Lifestyle Atelier Zitron** (Merino extrafine) (order # 2029, yardage 310 m/100g [340 yds/3.5 oz]) or **Unisono Atelier Zitron** (order # 2036, yardage 300 m/100g [328 yds/3.5 oz]); 3,5mm(US 4) circular needles 40cm/16in, and 3mm and 3,5mm DPNs, 3mm crochet hook, fork for pom pom, 1 stitch marker.

Size: One size to fit an average adult head. Finished Size: height: 19cm/7,5in (including earflap 25cm/9,8in); circumference: 48cm/19in.

If it's too wide/tight around your head, use smaller/bigger needles.

Gauge: in colorwork pattern: 29 sts x 30 rows per 10 x 10 cm [4 x 4 in]

Instructions:

I-Cord: With color **MC** and two DPN's 3mm, cast on 5 sts for the cords. Knit across, do not turn. Instead, slide your 5 sts down to the opposite side of the needle and keep the yarn at the back. Bring the yarn across the back and knit another row, while pulling the first stitch tight to eliminate any gaps across the 5 sts. Repeat until it reaches 15cm/6in in length.

Right Earflap: With **MC** and **CC** and size 3,5mm needle, make earflap-**charts** from row 1-36. Knit the earflap in garter stitches. For increasing knit a crossed stitch after every 2nd and penultimate st. It ends at the wrong side row. Break the yarn, place sts on the needle.

Left Earflap: Work as for right earflap. Do not break the yarn.

Begin Main Hat: Joining Rnd: With MC and circular ndl, knit left earflap sts, cast on 37sts for the front of your hat, knit right earflap sts, cast on 23sts for the back of your hat = 144sts.

Start to work in the round be careful not to twist. Place one marker at the beginning of the row. (**Start** in the **charts**)

Continue with **MC** and **CC** to follow chart through Rds 2-45.

Start decreasing in Rnd 46, knit 2 or 3sts together as shown, then continue to follow the pattern decreasing where indicated. When the crown becomes too small to work comfortably on the circular needle, switch to DPNs. At the end of the chart, you will have 9 sts remaining.

Cut the yarn. Use a yarn needle to pull the end through the remaining sts and pull it inside.

Edging:

With **CC** and crochet hook, do a single crochet around entire perimeter of your hat, along the back and front edges and the earflaps, behind the cords 3 chain sts, join with sl st.

Pom Poms: Make two 1¼" (3 cm) pom poms with **MC** and **CC**. <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fjxJFcm16r0>
Stitch them at the end of the cords.

Weave in all loose ends.
